Directions from Iowa City:

Take HWY 1 North from Iowa City 9 miles to Solon.
Turn West (left) on E. 5th St. by Bridge Bank. Follow out of town. This turns into 180th St, and then at the first curve turns into Mehaffey Bridge Rd. When you come down the big hill overlooking the lake, slow down and turn west (right) onto Cottage Reserve Rd. At the first sharp curve, keep right and enter Sailboat Rd. Field Day and both shelters are in this area. Look for signs.

Directions from Cedar Rapids:

Take I-380 south to exit 4 North Liberty (construction on Ely Rd/HWY 382 intersection). Turn east (left) and follow Penn Street through North Liberty. Travel until you cross the railroad tracks and reach the 4 way stop (Front Street/ Mehaffey Bridge Rd and Penn St). Turn left here on Mehaffey Bridge Rd. Proceed about 6 miles on Mehaffey Bridge Rd, crossing both Mehaffey Bridge/Iowa River and Lake Macbride's causeway. At the north end of Lake Macbride's causeway, slow down and turn left (West) on Cottage Reserve Rd. At the first sharp curve, keep right and enter Sailboat Rd. Field Day and both shelters are in this area. Look for signs.
