IWOA Minutes 02/27/2023 State Capitol, Des Moines, IA

Changes in our bylaws regarding membership categories were discussed and it was decided to discuss further at our next meeting after Russ Glime, Tim Meyer and Al Wagner get a chance to hammer out a few details.

There was a brief discussion regarding the IWOA scholarship. ISU has enough IWOA money to continue the scholarship for the next year or two. Al Wagner handed out a draft composed by his wife, Sharon, that would be an alternative to our current arrangement with ISU. General consensus was to table the proposal in order for every board member to study the information prior to our next board meeting.

Russ stated new brochures would cost around 80-90 cents per brochure. Because the brochure contains membership categories we will delay printing until after a decision has been made regarding the membership categories.
